

## **Holy Cross Episcopal Church Warner Memorial Garden**

### **Plantings and Floral Arrangements**

1. The basic design, planting and arrangement of the Warner Memorial Garden shall at all times be under the supervision of the Memorial Garden Committee, subject to final approval of the Vestry.
2. Contributions for additions or improvements will be gladly received by the Memorial Garden Committee, subject to Item 1 above.
3. The Memorial Garden Committee will also welcome contributions for floral arrangements or seasonal plantings to be used on special occasions, seasons or festivals.
4. Floral arrangements (fresh or artificial) may be left for two (2) weeks after an Interment or Inurnment service. After two (2) weeks, they will be removed.
5. No adornment or attachments of any kind to any structure within the garden will be permitted.

### **Prearrangements and Prepayment**

1. Arrangements for the Interment / Inurnment of ash remains should be made during the person's lifetime. To make arrangements, fill out an application with the required fee attached as shown in the Fee Schedule. The remainder of the fees must be paid within a year of the contract signing date. These fees are not tax deductible.
2. On approval of the application an acceptance will be issued. The application and the acceptance together constitute a contract between the Applicant and Holy Cross Episcopal Church.
3. The original of this contract will be kept in a permanent file in the Parish Office of Holy Cross Episcopal Church. A copy of the contract will be given to the Applicant. If an Applicant's current address or other related information changes, they must inform Holy Cross of all changes.
